<sup>2</sup> On August 30, 2017, defendant Peak entered a no contest plea to driving a motor vehicle under the influence of alcohol, driving a motor vehicle with a blood alcohol .08 or greater, and admitted a special allegation that she drove with a blood alcohol .15 or greater. A win for DA purposes is defined as doing justice, promoting public safety, and obtaining a conviction equal to your best offer. Since that was the final result here, this matter is weighed as a win.
