It has come to my attention that there is a proposed retreat/campground to be built next door to Pine Mountain Olive Farm. I have been fortunate to spend a significant amount of time there over the years, and I have come to love this area. I am concerned that this proposal would negatively impact the local habitat and threaten the abundant wildlife which survives off of the year round pond that is on the property right next to where the parking lot would be built. I also have heard the tents would have wood stoves inside, as well as open fire pits outside, and this sounds totally crazy to me. The fire danger on in this area without tourists is already high, due to the dry climate and high winds.
