625 Kings Court Update

We received the bids for the landscaping renovation project on January 30, 2018. The bids were more than double the budget the Board has authorized for the project. The cost difference was largely driven by the 'prevailing wage' requirement for the work. I discussed the issue with Counsel, and it appears there is nothing we can do about this requirement. Because of the dramatic cost increase, I have decided to cancel the project for this fiscal year. We may bring the project back to the Board next year with a better estimate of the cost.
