<b>Measure C - Mendocino Coast Health Care District</b> - "To continue essential healthcare at our local hospital by attracting and retaining high quality doctors/nurses, maintaining local emergency room, obstetric, surgical, ambulance and related 911 services, and making critical repairs and upgrades to medical equipment/facilities, shall Mendocino Coast Health Care District levy an annual special tax of \$144 per parcel for 12 years, raising approximately \$1,700,000 annually, with independent taxpayer oversight, no funds for administrators' salaries/pensions, and all funds dedicated to local healthcare facilities and services?"

<b>Measure D - Fort Bragg Rural Fire Protection District</b> - "Shall the Fort Bragg Rural Fire Protection District, by Ordinance, (1) Repeal the existing special tax of \$18.75 per unit, (2) Replacing it with a special tax not to exceed \$25.00 per unit, this proposed increase will bring in an estimated \$55,914.00 annually and shall be used to maintain and improve fire protection, suppression activities, prevention and to acquire and maintain equipment or apparatus and to increase our medical and rescue services?"
