What Tier Am I?



Retirement benefit tiers are determined by both type of membership and date of membership with MCERA as follows:

Membership types are broken up into three classifications, also referred to as groups: general, safety, and safety probation. Safety members are employed by the Sheriff's Department/Jail and Social Services. Safety Probation members are employed by Probation and Juvenile Hall. All other eligible employees are considered general members.

Date of membership is based on the following criteria:

- Your date of hire as a permanent employee working full-time or allocated at a minimum of 64 hours a pay period or
- Your date of transfer from a non-qualifying position to one that requires membership, or
- A date of membership prior to 1/1/2013 with another public retirement system with which you have established reciprocity may qualify you for General Tier 3, Safety Tier 2, or Safety Probation Tier 2.
