- **ANIMAL CARE:** Provides shelter to animals within Mendocino County's borders through one central shelter, located at 298 Plant Rd in Ukiah. The Shelter is open Tues, Thurs, Fri and Sat from 10am-5pm and Wed from 10am-7pm. They can be reached at (707) 463-4427.
- **CALIFORNIA CHILDREN'S SERVICES (CCS):** CCS is a state program that coordinates the care of children with certain diseases, physical limitations, or chronic health problems. This means CCS can get the special doctors and care your child needs. CCS doesn't cover all problems. CCS covers most problems that are physically disabling or that need to be treated with medicines, surgery, or rehabilitation. To get CCS, your child must: be under 21 years old; be a resident of California and have a family income under \$40,000 (your gross income on the state tax form). - **CHILD HEALTH & DISABILITY PREVENTION PROGRAM (CHDP):** Medical & Dental Health Check-ups are provided FREE for Babies, Children, and Youth through age 20 with full scope Medi-Cal. A complete health check-up may find medical, dental, and/or mental health problems before they become serious. Needed immunizations are given. A health check-up may be given, when required, for foster care, sports, or camp. You can usually get CHDP Check-Ups where you get your health care. If further medical, dental, or mental health services are needed, we will help you find them. Diagnosis and treatment will be paid for as long as your child is on Medi-Cal. - **ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH (EH):** Safeguards the public's health through community education and enforcement of state and local laws to ensure safe supplies of food and water, monitors proper management of wastes and hazardous materials, and abatement of hazardous environmental health conditions. They can be reached at (707) 234-6625, Ukiah or (707) 961-2714, Fort Bragg.
- **IMMUNIZATION (IZ) & TUBERCULIN (TB) TESTING:** Adult Immunizations (19yrs and older) are available. Recommended routine childhood immunizations (0 through 18yrs) are available, for those who qualify for the vaccine for Children (VFC) Program. TB testing is only available at Ukiah Immunization Clinics. For more information please call (707) 472-2600 or 1-800-734-7793 (Toll free for Mendocino County only).
- **MATERNAL, CHILD & ADOLESCENT HEALTH (MCAH) PROGRAM:** Develops systems with the goal to help protect and improve the health of women of childbearing age, children and adolescents through assessment of health care needs and assurance that access to quality health services is available. - **COMMUNITY, HEALTH, EDUCATION & ENGAGEMENT formally (PAPU):** Provides Alcohol, Other Drug and Tobacco Prevention Services. Also provides Community Health Promotion and Chronic Disease Prevention. (707) 472-2600 or 1-800-734-7793.
- **PUBLIC HEALTH NURSING SERVICES:** Public Health Nurses and bilingual Public Health Workers provide health information, help women and children get medical care, answer questions about pregnancy, child growth and development and parenting. - **TB CLINIC:** Tuberculosis follow-up. **BY APPOINTMENT ONLY** Please call the Ukiah office for more information (707) 472-2600 or 1-800-734-7793.
