Day Reporting Center Update:

Kirsty Thornton states there are currently 26 clients in BI and this is not including the 10 participants who are graduating.

Data Update:

She is currently working on Probations case management system with JustWare getting the reports fine-tuned to make sure we can extract the data you do want to see.

Bridgett was also given access to AEGIS reports so she can see what we are not able to pull from our own system. She has been in contact with Rose at the Sheriff's Department.

Captain Pearce informs Bridgett to speak with Ember in IT and not the Sheriff's Secretary. Bridgett states there is a certain report she has not received and it is from the jail. Captain Pearce states Bridgett needs to speak with Joyce Spears at the jail regarding that report.

NCCT Update:

NCCT ended on June 2, 2017 and there is no further update as to NCCT.



CCP Members Report Out:

Bekkie Emery states she appreciates Kevin’s presentation to the Board of Supervisors and he did a great job.

Kenny Spain states the budget was adopted from the state level and will be analyzed

Tim Schraeder states he was disappointed to hear we did not get the Prop 47 grant. Kevin Kelley states there were 15 counties who got the grant and there were phone calls made requesting a report as to the denial. Kevin states Bridgett, Cathy and hi met with a grant writer/consultant for insight. Further discussion held regarding the grant.

Captain Pearce states 25 million came through and were award the full 25 million for a new building at the jail.

Jacque Williams states Fort Street Project did get a Partnership Health Grant to expand how many sober living beds. One they build out a new building they will have 60 treatment beds rather than 40 and will have 30 sober living beds. In the new configuration the women’s sober living environment will be a separate structure.

Captain Pearce states most of the inmates who were part of the NCCT program are now enrolled in a welding class at the college.
