Property Tax Relief

• Property Tax Postponement for Senior Citizens, Blind, or Disabled Persons. On September 28, 2014, the Governor signed AB 2231 (Statutes of 2014, Chapter 703), which reinstates the State Controller's Property Tax Postponement Program with some revisions. This program will allow senior, blind, or disabled citizens with an annual household income of \$35,500 or less and 40% equity in their homes to apply to defer payment of property taxes on their principal residence. Under this bill, applications may be filed with the State Controller's Office beginning October 1, 2018 and will be accepted through February 11, 2019. Applications will not be accepted prior to October 1, 2018.
