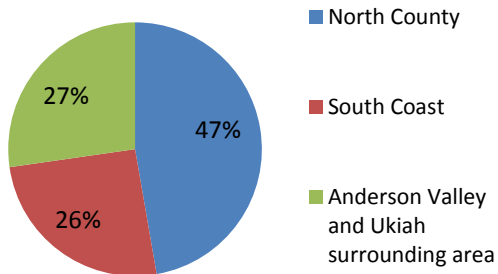

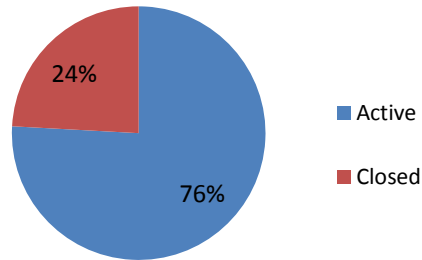

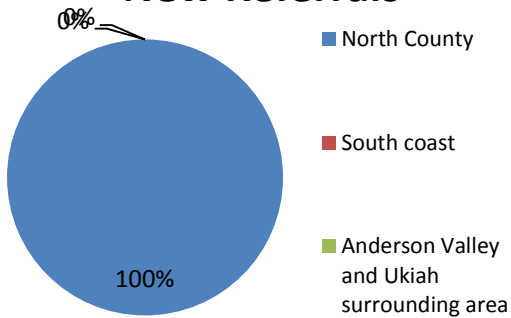

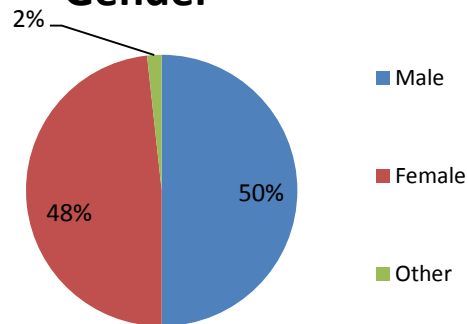
Active/Closed Cases



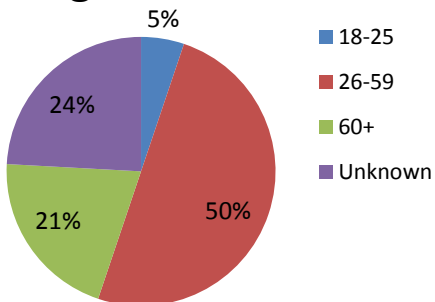

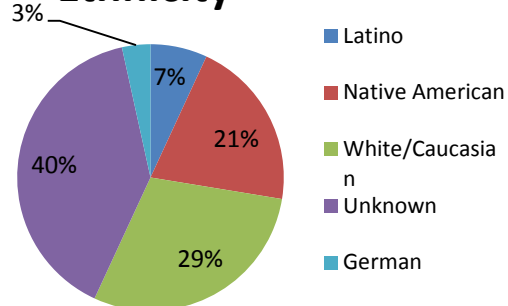
