Not to make a big deal of this but I just wanted to give you a heads up that this morning a Douglas Kronzer, neighbor on Shane drive to the Jade court property came around to the gate holding the use permit notification he said he just got in the mail. Kyla, a manager went out to talk to him and he aggressively (physically pressing her back) berated her about the noise of "people talking" coming from our property. It was the middle of the day. According to Kyla he smelled of alcohol and commented that he didn't care what we were growing and continued to complain about the noise and insisted that the neighbors music was ours and insisted we have a "party environment" here. Kyla directed him to me and I spoke to him shortly after. I told him we would try and keep the noise down but he demanded that we keep people inside and and said he would make a noise complaint.

People talking is not a basis for a noise complaint. We certainly aren't loud. People are only outside for brief periods at break times and I don't think laughter can be taken as a serious complaint. I just wanted to give you guys a heads up about it and hope we don't suffer a surge of complaints after receiving this notice and more importantly, if we do they can be identified as bearing prejudice as we have had no complaints to my knowledge in the past. It is my understanding that only complaints underscoring code violations can bear influence on the use permit application. I hope that holds.
