### **Mendocino County Homeless Services Continuum of Care (MCHSCoC) Board Meeting**

The Mendocino County Homeless Services Continuum of Care monthly public meeting is Monday, February 11, 2019 at 1120 S. Dora St., Ukiah, in Conference room 1. There will be two presentations, one by Heidi Corrado from the Mendocino County Aids & Viral Hepatitis Network (MCAVHN) on opioid safety, and a second by Zenia Leyva Chou on the current activities of the Hillside Health Clinic in Ukiah. Additionally Board and general members will provide updates on current activities.

The MCHSCoC Board will vote to:

- Accept or reject the nominations put forward for upcoming Board seats,
- Accept or reject the updated manual for Coordinated Entry and Discharge Planning (CEDP),
- Accept or reject definitions of homelessness both in general and for the purposes of service triage,
- Accept or reject the formation of an ad hoc committee to plan and execute trainings.

The Mendocino County Homeless Services Continuum of Care program is a collaboration of individuals, and agencies committed to the goal of ending

homelessness in our community. This group is instrumental in bringing Federal Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and State (multiple departments) funding into the county to increase access to housing, and assist families and individuals experiencing or at-risk of homelessness, access and maintain stable housing. This group focuses on developing solutions to homelessness that also positively impact the larger community. Community members and agency staff interested in understanding some of the issues of homelessness in Mendocino County, and working on solutions to end homelessness, are welcome to attend these public meetings.
