The Mendocino County Homeless Services Continuum of Care monthly public meeting will be held on Monday, January 14, 2019 from 1:30 p.m. to 3:30 p.m. at 1120 S. Dora St., Ukiah, in Conference room 1. Agenda topics will include:

- The Coordinated Entry Process, Policies & Procedure
- The California Department of Housing & Community Development – California Emergency Solutions & Housing (CESH) funds
- Reports on – clients housed, the Point in Time Count, Committee activities, Brown Act trainings & the Homeless Emergency Aid Program (HEAP) funds
- Discussion – the definitions of homelessness in Mendocino County and triage to paths of service

The Mendocino County Homeless Services Continuum of Care program is a collaboration of individuals and agencies committed to the goal of ending homelessness in our community.
