ALUC Role and Responsibilities

- Purpose
 - Required by State Law
 - Protect public health, safety & welfare
 - Promote orderly airport development
 - Minimize conflicts
- Responsibilities
 - Airport land use compatibility planning
 - Review local agency actions
 - Determine consistency

ALUC Limitations



- No authority over airport operations
- No authority over existing land uses
- No authority over federal, state or tribal lands
- No direct ability to implement land use measures



Airport Land Use Compatibility Plan (ALUCP)


- Function
 - Promote compatibility between airport & land uses
 - Establish compatibility review criteria
 - Recommend land use measures for local adoption
- Requirements

- Guided by current Airport Land Use Planning Handbook (2011)
- Reflect current Airport Master Plan/Airport Layout Plan (2015)

	Airport Plans	ALUCP	General Plan
Geographic Scope	On-Airport Property	Within Airport Influence Area	Within City Limits and Sphere of Influence
Purpose	Guide development of airport facilities	Promote airport/land use compatibility	Guide land use development


Local Agency Responsibilities

- Attain general plan consistency
- Refer certain land use actions to ALUC for review
- Alternatively, take steps to overrule ALUC action



Compatibility Factors

- Airport Influence Area
 - Noise
 - Safety
 - Airspace protection
 - Overflight



Why Update the UKI ALUCP?




- New ALUC guidance published by Caltrans Division of Aeronautics in 2011
- New Airport Layout Plan showing airport development proposals not reflected in current UKI ALUCP




FAA-Approved Airport Layout Plan

UKI Compatibility Zones - Composite




UKI Compatibility Map/Handbook Safety Zone Comparison
