The County of Mendocino Department of Environmental Health, Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) has accepted an application package for a Solid Waste Facility Permit for a Compostable Materials Handling Facility. The LEA is certified by the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery, formerly known as the California Integrated Waste Management Board, to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste facilities within the County of Mendocino. <u>Description of Proposed Project</u>: The submitted application package proposes to construct a compostable materials facility at 3201 Taylor Drive in Ukiah. The proposed facility will compost green material, agricultural material, food material, and other permitted materials, up to 50,000 tons annually. Composting will occur on a cement pad with an in-floor aeration and leachate collection system, and will be covered to control temperature and moisture content.

<u>Purpose of Meeting</u>: The purpose of the meeting is for any interested parties to learn more about the proposed permit and to provide comments to the LEA regarding the proposed action.

<u>LEA Findings</u>: The LEA has reviewed and considered the submitted application package, and has determined it to be complete and correct. The proposed project complies with the California Title 14 requirements for Compostable Materials Handling Facilities.
