Dear Mr. Scoles:

Pursuant to request, dated April 24, 2008 the Mendocino County Department of Transportation (MCDoT) completed the required response form with the following comments:

- Little River Airport Recommendation #1 Replace the Runway Lights. MCDoT opened contractor bids to do this work 5-29-08 and expect to complete work this construction season. There is sufficient Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) funding to complete the work this year. Contract is to be awarded June 22, 2008. Construction is to start in August 2008.
- Little River Airport Recommendation #2 GPS Instrument Landing. FAA Flight Procedures Branch is working on establishing GPS approach instructions for Runway 29.
- Little River Airport Recommendation #3, General #1 Permanent Emergency Generator. The current approved Airport Improvement Plan does not lists this as a priority project; thus, the new electrical vault will be set up for emergency generator. MCDoT is seeking ways to acquire a generator possibly law enforcement seizure.
- Little River Airport Recommendation #4, General #4 County Microwave System. MCDoT has assigned channels for use by the road maintenance staff. Additional access is beyond MCDoT authority and is a policy decision for emergency services.

FINDINGS □ I (we) agree with findings numbered: 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6. 8, 9, 10, 12
 □ I (we) disagree wholly or partially with the findings numbered: #11 – there is space which could be used for tents or mobile units; however, some of that space is planned for future uses and MCDoT cannot confirm if there would be enough room to house all in the area. # 7 – 50+/- year old lighting system failed in October 2007. Plans for replacement of runway lighting system and runway pavement rehabilitation were completed April 2008. FAA-AIP grant for runway lighting and pavement rehabilitation was received in June 2008. Construction should be complete in November 2008. (Attach a statement specifying any portions of the findings that are disputed; include an explanation of the reasons therefore.)
