WHEREAS, Article XIII B of the California Constitution has been amended by Proposition 111 to change the price and population factors that may be used by local jurisdictions in setting appropriations limits,

WHEREAS, The documents evidencing the calculation of the FY 17-18 Gann limit have been made available to the public fifteen days prior to the scheduled and noticed meeting of the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors. Such documents were published on the website of the Mendocino County Auditor-Controller.
