***GOVERNOR'S APPOINTMENT, GEORGEANNE CROSKY, ANNOUNCES SHE WILL
NOT RUN FOR THIRD DISTRICT SUPERVISOR SEAT IN 2018***

Dr. Georgeanne Croskey was appointed to the Third District Supervisorial seat on May 9, 2017, after Supervisor Tom Woodhouse resigned. Ms. Croskey has been doing the job since then along with her veterinary practice, Mendocino Equine and Livestock.

This week, Supervisor Croskey announced that she will not be running for office due to family commitments. Supervisor Croskey's husband accepted a position and the family will be leaving Mendocino County.

"I am a mother, a wife, and a public servant. I love my family and I love serving the Third District. However, my husband and children need me to be a wife and mother first. It is with great regret that I will be leaving this position and Mendocino County."

Supervisor Croskey will complete her term as Third District Supervisor on December 31, 2018. Then the family will be reunited. In the meantime, Supervisor Croskey said, "I am in the process of selling my veterinary practice and will continue to perform veterinary work on a part time basis. With the pending sale of my practice and no campaign for the 2018 election, I will dedicate my time to serving the constituents and addressing the issues facing the district and the county as a whole. I believe this will allow me to concentrate on the needs of the district, rather than dividing my time between my veterinary practice, supervisor work and managing a campaign. I commit to do the best work I can for my constituents in the Third District."
