REQUEST: Review and consider a recommendation to the Board of Supervisors on proposed adoption of Mendocino County Code Chapter 22.18 – Commercial Cannabis Activity Land Use Development Ordinance and corresponding proposed amendments to Mendocino County Code Chapter 10A.17 – Mendocino Cannabis Cultivation Ordinance, and Chapter 20.242 – Cannabis Cultivation Sites. Chapter 22.18 establishes a discretionary permitting process for cannabis cultivation activities.
